Before traveling abroad, make sure to:



GET INFORMED about your destination at [*travel.state.gov/destination*](https://travel.state.gov/destination), and plan for the unexpected at [*travel.state.gov/crisis*](https://travel.state.gov/crisis).



GET REQUIRED DOCUMENTS, such as your passport and visas.



GET ENROLLED in the Smart Traveler Enrollment Program (STEP) at [*step.state.gov*](https://step.state.gov) to receive security and emergency alerts.



GET INSURED for medical, evacuation, and other unexpected expenses.



Carry this card with you when you go abroad.
